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## APPENDIX 10

### Clerk's Report and Assets Report from 16.05.2021 to 12.06.2021

This report is to provide an update on actions taken and not covered elsewhere on the Agenda within the time period above:

- The period for the exercise of Public Rights with regard to the Annual Return will run from 14<sup>th</sup> June to the 23<sup>rd</sup> July 2021. Information has been posted on the Notice Boards and all relevant information is on the Parish Council's Website.
- Work on the second bollard has been completed and combination padlocks are now on both bollards.
- Three A3 'Bag it and Bin it' signs have been mounted around the village – two at the top of Mill Lane and one at the entrance to the quarry on Bescaby Lane.
- All information needed has been submitted to LCC for the purchase of the gates and MVAS.
- An initial quote of £1885 has been received to install a second tap at the allotments. This includes installing a 100m underground pipe, branching off the existing water facility and building a small housing for the tap. Further quotes can be sought if requested.
- The RoSPA inspection of the Play Park was carried out on 7<sup>th</sup> June 2021. A few minor issues were reported that will be dealt with over time. The report has been circulated to all Councillors.
- The work felling trees and dealing with an ash stump have been completed on the Allotment site. The work has been carried out very tidily.
- Refurbishment information about the interior of the Pavilion has been received from Mowbray Rangers FC and a specification for the works will be discussed and drawn up in due course.
- A meeting took place with Martin Fagan of Community Heartbeat. A site for a stand-alone defibrillator has been identified on the Brampton Valley Estate and the developers will be contacted to discuss the installation.
