Clerk's Report and Assets Report from 13.02.2022 to 12.03.2022

This report is to provide an update on actions taken and not covered elsewhere on the Agenda within the time period above:

- All the necessary information has been submitted to Unity Trust and we have been advised that the account is now open. It is hoped to change banks at the beginning of April.
- Our snow warden has been issued with his hi-viz jacket, boots, gloves, a wheelbarrow and a spade. An extra wheelbarrow and spade which were collected at the same time are being stored in the Council lock-up.
- We are still waiting to hear about defibrillator installation in Thorpe Arnold.
- The Annual Parish Assembly has been advertised on the noticeboards and via Facebook. A representative from the Village Hall Trustees will attend. We are waiting on responses from Waltham C of E School, the Scouts and St Mary Magdalene Church in Waltham. The Rev'd Dr Mary Barr has promised to advertise it in Thorpe Arnold. The agenda will be issued on Wednesday 23rd March.
- Mr Ellis Jones was provided with an update received from the architects. They are aware that the closest sewer is at the junction of Melton Spinney Road and Waltham Road and application has the details of possible options which will be finalised closer to the time. The building will be 4m from Mr Jones' boundary and his house is a further 2m away.
- Two places have been booked on the Managing Closed Churchyards course on April 26th 2022.
- Groundworks have approved the application to Tesco stores to fund the bee-keeping project in the allotments on the High Street. Funding will be anywhere from £500 to £1500 and the application will be in local stores for 3 months until the end of June.
- The Parish Council have successfully set up a NEST pension account.
- The fund-raising focus for the two farmers' markets to take place on the Play Field and approved at the last meeting is Waltham C of E School as before.
