PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER NO 3 2020

This Order is made by Melton Borough Council the "Council") under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 because it appears to the Council that in the interests of the owner of the land crossed by the footpath and described in paragraph 1 of this Order it is expedient that the line of the footpath should be diverted

**** has agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this order and any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the path into a fit condition for use by the public.

Leicestershire County Council has been consulted and has consented to the making of the order as required by section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER:

1. The public right of way over the land situate at Waltham on the Wolds and shown by a bold continuous line on the attached map contained in this order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up after 30 days from the date of confirmation of this Order.
2. There shall at the end of 30 days from the date of confirmation of this order be a public footpath over the land situate at Waltham on the Wolds described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown as a bold broken line on the map attached to this Order.
3. Notwithstanding the provisions of Article 1 these provisions for the extinguishment of the public right of way shall not come into force until the Highway Authority acting by its proper officer shall have certified that the following works have been carried out to its satisfaction in accordance with Section 119(3) of the 1980 Act
 - a) The alternative route where it does not fall on a carriageway footway shall have a width of four metres consisting of 2m bound surface with 1m grass verge in either side.
 - b) Any form of boundary feature at point N shall have a 1.5m gap left for the footpath
 - c) The provision of two footpath fingerposts in accordance with the Leicestershire County Council standard specification drawing SD/FP/7* at the locations shown on the plan (grid reference 480155 324679 and 480120 324530). The northern sign to be specially worded to indicate the Mowbray Way.
4. Where immediately before the date on which the footpath is diverted there is apparatus under, in, on, over, along or across it belonging to statutory undertakers for the purpose of carrying on their undertaking, the undertakers shall continue to have the same rights in respect of the apparatus as they then had.

SCHEDULE

PART 1

Description of site of existing footpaths to be diverted

The section of footpath F1 at Waltham on the Wolds within the Borough of Melton shown as a bold continuous line on the attached order map (Plan Number 16009/FD/E99 F1) and extends from point M at Grid Reference 48011 32451 in a generally northerly direction for a distance of approximately 25 metres to point L at Grid Reference 48011 32455. Also that section of path shown as bold continuous line which extends from point K at Grid Reference 48012 32459 in a generally northerly direction for a distance of approximately 50 metres to point B at Grid Reference 48013 32464.

Also the section of Footpath E99 at Waltham on the Wolds within the Borough of Melton shown as a bold continuous line on the attached order Map (Plan Number 16009/FD/E99 F1) and extends from point A at Grid Reference 48009 32462 in generally east-north-east then east then north then easterly directions through points B,C and D for a total distance of approximately 130 metres to point E at Grid Reference 48016 32470.

Description of site of new footpaths

An alternative footpath F1 instead to be created shown as a bold broken line on the attached order Map (Plan number 16009/FD/E99 F1) running from point N at Grid Reference 48011 32453 in a generally northerly direction for a distance of approximately 20 metres to point L previously described. Also a footpath shown as a bold broken line running from point K previously described, in a generally northerly direction to join the new route of Footpath E99 at point H at Grid Reference 48014 32464.

Also an alternative Footpath E99 instead to be created shown as a bold broken line on the attached order Map (Plan number 16009/FD/E99 F1) running from point A, previously described in generally east-north-east then northerly directions through points F, G, B, H, I, J and D for a total distance of approximately 125 metres to join the existing route of Footpath E99 at point E previously described.
