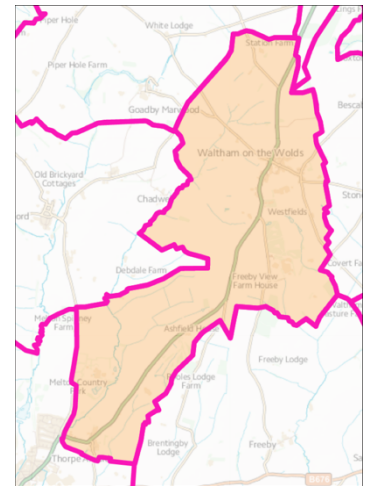

**1. Meeting aims**

- Tell the Group about the outcomes from examination and the resulting amendments to the NP.
- Decide our approach for the referendum.
- Agree specific actions.

**2. Discussion**

- We went through the examiner's report and explained the changes to the referendum version of the NP.
- It was generally agreed that the outcome from the examination was good although the process had been long and stressful.
- The elections team at MBC has not announced the timing of the referendum.
- We agreed that we would communicate with parishioners ahead of the referendum in the following ways:
  - Letter drop to all houses.
  - Banners at both villages.
  - Drop-in events at both village halls. To run from 4 to 8pm. 3 or 4 full copies of the NP to be available for inspection. At least 2 members of the NPG to be in attendance at any time.
- Note that the aim of the above actions is to encourage people to vote (we are not permitted to lobby for a yes vote).

**4. Agreed actions:**

- ML to draft letter and circulate for NPG ok.
- POC to design and arrange printing and siting of banners.
- ML to communicate timing of referendum, once this is known, and arrange letter drop, printing of NP copies, event dates and venues etc.
- DL to assist with Thorpe Arnold event.
- All to agree rota for drop-in events once timing is known.
